Organics Diversion and Edible Food Recovery

Mandates implementation of a statewide strategy to

REDUCE METHANE EMISSIONS

Through organic waste prevention and reduction

Organic Waste Reduction Goals

- 50% reduction in statewide disposal of organic waste from the 2014 level by 2020
- 75% reduction in statewide disposal of organic waste from the 2014 level by 2025
- 20% of edible food currently disposed of is recovered for human consumption by 2025

Still Developing the Plan

Regulations may include -

- Organic waste prevention
- Organic waste collection service
- Edible food recovery and donation
- Education and outreach activities

Implementation Calendar

- 2018 – Regulations available for adoption
- 2022 – Regulations take effect and are enforceable
- 2024 – Regulations may require jurisdiction to impose penalties on generators for noncompliance

What is Organic Waste?*

- Food and green waste
- Landscape and pruning waste
- Applicable textiles and carpet
- Wood, lumber and fiber
- Biosolids, digestate and sludge

What is Edible Food?*

- Food that is recoverable for human consumption
